AFFIDAVIT OF TODD MACKAY

I, Todd MacKay, of Regina, in the Province of Saskatchewan, MAKE OATH
AND SAY THAT:

1. I am the Prairie Director for the Canadian Taxpayers Federation ("CTF") and
as such I have personal knowledge of the facts and matters deposed to herein. Where stated
to be on information and belief, I verily believe the same to be true.

2. The CTF is a non-profit corporation incorporated pursuant to the provisions of
the *Canada Not-for-Profit Corporations Act*. The mandate of the CTF is to promote the
responsible and efficient use of tax money. To that end, the CTF is engaged in various
public awareness campaigns to promote fiscal transparency at all levels of government.

3. On a number of occasions I have gone to the website maintained by the Onion
Lake Cree Nation ("Onion Lake") to look for financial disclosure documents. To date, I
have been unable to find Onion Lake's financial disclosure documents. In addition, I have
been unable to find Onion Lake's financial disclosure documents on the website maintained
by Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada.

4. On October 4, 2016 at approximately 1:00 p.m., I searched the following
websites for Onion Lake's financial disclosure documents as required by the *First Nations
Financial Transparency Act*:

6. I swear this affidavit in support of an application compelling Onion Lake to comply with the provisions of the *First Nations Financial Transparency Act*.
