Notes:

In most cases severance payment is a lump sum equal to 50 per cent of the total sessional allowance plus any additional salary.

Pension is based on best five years salary-wise multiplied by total accrual based on time served.

A member must serve 6-years to qualify for a pension.

A member who is over 55 is not eligible for a severance as he/she will immediately receive a pension.

A member under the age of 55 is eligible for a severance even if he/she qualifies for a pension.

*Indexation for inflation is calculated at 2 per cent per annum.
