Alberta's government now spends \$6.5 billion per year more than the government of British Columbia. Yet, BC still delivers expansive social programs and services to its residents.

Alberta could save \$1,539 per person, per year, by spending at BC levels.

Alberta is now set to borrow for day-to-day operational spending, ramping up debt, deficits and debt interest payments.
