Re: Access to Information Request No. CIC 14/09G

We acknowledge your Access to Information Request was received in this office on May 22, 2009 requesting access to the following:

"A copy of the report outlining options to expand or replace Mosaic Stadium."

CIC has now completed its review of your request. Access to the report is granted in part. Portions of the report have been severed pursuant to Section 8 of *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the Act). A copy of the report, *Stadium Concept Review: A Summary Report* is enclosed. This summary report includes all the information included in the original report, but excludes certain confidential financial information and commentary prepared for the Government of Saskatchewan. Access to parts of the report is refused pursuant to the Act on the basis that if disclosed would release information that:

- 1. Was created to present advice, proposals, recommendations, analyses or policy options to the Executive Council, in accordance with subsection 16(1)(a) of the Act.
- 2. Could reasonably be expected to disclose advice, proposals, recommendations, analyses or policy options developed by or for CIC or a member of the Executive Council in accordance with section 17(1)(a) of the Act.
- 3. Could reasonably be expected to disclose positions, plans, procedures, criteria or instructions developed for the purpose of contractual or other negotiations by or on behalf of the Government of Saskatchewan or a government institution, or considerations that relate to those negotiations in accordance with section 17(1)(c) of the Act.
- 4. Could reasonably be expected to disclose information, including the proposed plans, policies or projects of a government institution, the disclosure of which

could reasonably be expected to result in disclosure of a pending policy or budgetary decision of a pending policy decision or budgetary item in accordance with section 17(1)(g) of the Act.

5. Could reasonably be expected to disclose information, the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to prejudice the economic interest of the Government of Saskatchewan or a government institution in accordance with section 18(1)(f) of the Act.

If you would like to exercise your right to request a review of this decision, you may do so by completing a Request for Review form and forwarding it to the Saskatchewan Information Privacy Commissioner within one year of this notice. Your completed form can be sent to #503-1801 Hamilton Street, Regina, SK, S4P 4B4. This form is available at the same location which you applied for access or by contacting the Office of the Information Privacy Commissioner at (306) 787-8350.
