

Canadian Taxpayers Federation Tax Issue Survey National Survey n=1,000, Margin of Error <u>+</u>3.1% January 4 – 8, 2008

The following questions deal with the federal <u>personal</u> income tax system in Canada. We are talking about taxes on individuals like yourself, not businesses and corporations.

Q1.1 Would you say federal income tax rates are much too low, somewhat too low, about right, somewhat too high or much too high?

Much too low	2%

Q1.2 Do you find the federal income tax system to be very simple, somewhat simple, somewhat complicated or very complicated?
