Request for Access to Personal Information, Reference No. 2017-G-0019

On July 27, 2017 the Calgary Board of Education (the "CBE") received your Request for Access to Information under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the "FOIP Act"). You requested the following:

"Provide information on the number of teachers who were eligible to receive a step increase in 2017-2018 and the number who will receive step increases. Please also include information on the estimated cost of step increases for teachers in 2017-2018 and the financial impact of the new collective bargaining agreement."

Timeline: January 2017 - Present

The information you requested is enclosed. As per section 10(2) of the FOIP Act, records were created in order to respond to your request.

Under section 65 of the FOIP Act, you may ask the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review any matter concerning this response to your request. You have 60 days from the date of this notice to request a review by writing to the Commissioner at 410, 9925 – 109 Street, Edmonton, Alberta, T5K 2J8.

When requesting a review, you need to provide the Office of the Commissioner with the following information:

- The reference number quoted at the top of this notice;
 - 2. a copy of this letter; and
 - 3. a copy of the original request form that you sent to CBE.
