Re: Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy (FOIP) Act Request for Access to General Information

On May 22, 2014, the Alberta Justice and Solicitor General (AJSG) FOIP Office received your request under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy (FOIP) Act* for access to records containing general information.

Specifically, you requested access to "documentation on the number of inmates or people in custody who have been accidentally or unintentionally released since January 1, 2010. Please break out the number of incidents by year, when the person was accidentally let go and when they were taken into custody again" for the time period of January 1, 2010 to April 1, 2014.

Enclosed is a copy of two pages of records that were created in response to your request. These records were created in accordance with our duty to assist under section 10(2) of the *FOIP Act*. The first page is the requested statistics and the second provides background regarding the information provided.
