Comments by the Hon. Gary Filmon, former Progressive Conservative Premier of Manitoba on Manitoba Hydro's risky \$34 billion plan:

"I can't understand why the Government is afraid to have an objective, independent review of Manitoba Hydro's 'decade of investment'. At \$34 billion, this proposal represents by far the largest commitment made by a Crown Corporation in the province's history.

Given that Hydro is proposing to make this massive capital investment primarily for commercial gain and not for the imminent needs of the Manitoba ratepayers, it must be regarded as a risk investment and not a necessity for the system. Under these circumstances, the proposal demands the most open, thorough review possible, by a panel of experts familiar with all aspects of the utility's business and the competitive market into which Hydro proposes to sell.

If the proposal is sound, it will be supported by the expert review and the Government will have the support and credibility it needs to proceed with this massive undertaking."
