An online survey.



400 Manitoba residents aged 18+.



Completed between 22nd to the 24th of March 2024, inclusive, using Leger's online panel.



Typically, a margin of error is not associated with a non-probability sample (i.e. a web panel in this case). For comparative purposes, though, a probability sample of 400 respondents would have a margin of error of ±4.9%, 19 times out of 20.





Strong public support for Premier Kinew asking PM to not to raise carbon Leger tax. Support particularly strong outside Winnipeg in rural parts of the province.




