

Petition: Don't Hurt N.B. Businesses with Property Tax Hikes

New Brunswick businesses already pay too much tax at every level, including property taxes. Commercial property taxes in New Brunswick are [among the highest](#) in Canada.

Yet, New Brunswick Liberal MLA Gerry Lowe introduced [a bill](#) in the legislature earlier this year to add a new property tax on machinery and equipment for businesses. That bill was withdrawn, but the issue is being studied by a legislative committee.

Raising property taxes in New Brunswick would drive away investment and make life more difficult for hardworking job creators in the province.
