**Re: Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy (FOIPOP) Act Application
File No. NSB-15-3 / NS Open Event (2014) – Names of Participants**

FOIPOP Application

Your application requests access to the following records:

[A copy of] ... a record that lists the names, company / organization of each participant who used Nova Scotia Open (2014) tickets (invitations / playing spots / passes) that were allocated to NSBI [and the NS Tourism Agency] in accordance with sub-clauses 4(e), (f), (g), (h), (k) and (l) of the NSBI / NS Tourism Agency / SportBox GolfFest Nova Scotia Event agreement, dated June 3, 2014.

NSBI is responding regarding the tickets that were allocated to NSBI under the agreement. Per my letter of May 15, 2015, Nova Scotia Tourism Agency (NSTA) is responding separately regarding the tickets that were allocated to NSTA under the agreement.

Notice of Access Decision – Section 7(2) FOIPOP Act:

Requested record:

The FOIPOP application seeks access to “a record that lists ... who used ... tickets”. NSBI has conducted a careful search of its records and determined it does not have in its custody / control a record of who used tickets. Such a record was not created by NSBI and does not exist. Pursuant to s. 7(2)(b) FOIPOP Act, the requested record is not in the custody / control of NSBI.

NSBI kept a pre-event record listing who accepted an invitation to receive a ticket and to which NSBI employee tickets were handed for distribution to invitees. NSBI did not keep a record of who actually used the ticket and attended the event.

Reasonably responsive record:

In keeping with s. 7(1)(a) FOIPOP Act (the duty to assist an applicant and respond openly, accurately and completely) NSBI has decided the pre-event record of who accepted an invitation to receive a ticket is reasonably responsive to the application and processed the record accordingly in response to the application.

NSBI has in its custody / control six (6) records that list who accepted an invitation to receive tickets to the following events:

- **Hospitality pass** (i.e. general admission plus access to the hospitality tent):
 - Canada Cup (June 30) – Record #1
 - Tournament Play (July 3 to 6) – Record #3 to #6.
- **Playing spot** for the NS Open Pro-Am event (July 2) – Record #2.

After reviewing the records in accordance with the *FOIPOP Act* and considering the interests of affected third party individuals and the access / privacy purpose of the *FOIPOP Act*, NSBI has decided pursuant to s. 7(2)(a) *FOIPOP Act* you are entitled to access the records **in part** with specific and limited third party personal information exempted from disclosure in accordance with s. 20(1) *FOIPOP Act* (the exemption for third party personal information).

Exempted third party personal information

The exempted information is personal information of a third party (i.e. an individual's name, association or employment history) where the individual is a third party guest of a third party guest of NSBI. Unlike the other third party personal information to which access is being granted, disclosure of the "guest of guest" personal information does not reveal details of a discretionary benefit granted to a third party by a public body, as the discretionary benefit was granted not by NSBI, but by a third party (i.e. by the third party guest of NSBI). Section 20(4)(h) and (i) *FOIPOP Act* do not apply nor do the other circumstances under which disclosure is not an unreasonable invasion of personal privacy. Section 20(4) *FOIPOP Act* does not apply.

None of the circumstances under which personal information is presumed to be an unreasonable invasion of third party personal privacy apply. Section 20(3) *FOIPOP Act* does not apply.

Of the circumstances listed in s. 20(2) *FOIPOP Act* to be considered in determining whether disclosure would or would not be an unreasonable invasion of third party personal privacy, it was considered that the information would only be as accurate as the information provided to NSBI by the third party. NSBI did not extend the invitation so the information could be inaccurate or unreliable. Section 20(2)(g) *FOIPOP Act* is relevant and weighs in favour of non-disclosure. No other circumstances were identified as relevant.

On balance it was determined that disclosure of the "guest of guest" personal information would be an unreasonable invasion of personal privacy, that s. 20(1) *FOIPOP Act* applies to the information and it must be withheld.

To ensure a complete and accurate response, in accordance with s. 7(2)(b) *FOIPOP Act*, NSBI confirms it does not have in its custody / control a record that lists who accepted an invitation to receive tickets to the following events:

- **Pre-Event Media Day 18-hole event playing spot (TBD)**

[NOTE: The event was not held.]

- **Canada Cup Evening Reception invitations (June 30)**
- **NS Open Pro-Am Pairings Party invitations (July 1)**
- **NS Open Pro-Am Evening Reception invitations (July 2); and**
- **General admission passes**

[NOTE: NSBI did not create a record listing the allocation of these tickets.]

Release of Records:

In fulfillment of the above access decision, please find enclosed your copy of the records as decided for disclosure.

EXPLANATORY NOTES (Records #1 to #6):

NOTE 1: The records are a pre-event list of who accepted an invitation to receive a ticket. The records are not a list of who received a ticket, who used a ticket or who participated in the event. Substitutions may have occurred.

NOTE 2: The July 5 tournament play event was cancelled due to weather and passes honoured the following day July 6.

With release of the enclosed records your application is complete and the file closed. Thank you.

Right to Request a Review

You have the right to ask the FOIPOP Review Officer to review the above access decision.
