Your Access to Information Request under *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* was received in the Privacy, Access and Ethics Department on June 10, 2010.

You have asked for a breakdown of promotional and sponsorship items from SGI from 2008 to 2010; given that the 2010 fiscal year is not yet complete, we are only able to provide information for the fiscal years 2008 and 2009. We would be happy to provide information for 2010 to you after December 31, 2010. Your request for information from 2008 and 2009 has been fully granted.

### **Traffic Safety Promotion**

This area used the following promotional items: children's mittens, adult gloves, key tags, shaped pens, temporary tattoos, sunglass clips, catch-alls, knapsacks, t-shirts, colouring puzzles, frisbees, bubble pens, beach balls, coloured pencils, cube pens and bike helmets. These items were distributed at community events such as Homecoming Days, bike rodeos, sports days, children's festivals, and during the Seat Belt Challenge, where communities in close proximities challenged each other to improve seat belt usage rates, and other public awareness activities.
