**Re: Request for access to information under Part 2 of *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*: Application Number 18 01 54**

Dear Todd:

On January 12, 2018, the City of Winnipeg received your request for access to the following:

*Please provide a list of all reimbursements provided by unions to the City of Winnipeg for the years 2015, 2016 and 2017. If possible, please provide this information in a spreadsheet including the date each reimbursement was received, the amount, the union from which it came, and the employee on whose behalf the reimbursement was made. (Please feel free to call or email if it would be helpful to discuss alternative ways to provide this information).*

The information you requested was in an electronic format but not the format you requested, so we created a record for release to you under section 10(2), and, in accordance with section 14(1)(a) of the Act, a copy is enclosed.

*10(2) If a record exists but is not in the form requested by the applicant, the head of the public body may create a record in the form requested if the head is of the opinion that it would be simpler or less costly for the public body to do so.*

Access to the reimbursements (date, union, and amount) is granted in full. Detailed information about the employee on whose behalf the amounts have been reimbursed was not provided, as this information is protected under s.17(1)(2)(e) of the Act:

**Disclosure harmful to a third party's privacy**

17(1) The head of a public body shall refuse to disclose personal information to an applicant if the disclosure would be an unreasonable invasion of a third party's privacy.

**Disclosures deemed to be an unreasonable invasion of privacy**

17(2) A disclosure of personal information about a third party is deemed to be an unreasonable invasion of the third party's privacy if

(e) the personal information relates to the third party's employment, occupational or educational history;

Subsection 17(1) is a general mandatory exception protects the personal information of third parties (third parties are considered to be neither yourself as the applicant or city employees). This general clause is used in conjunction with clause 17(2)(e), which is applied to information constituting employment history of individual employees.

Please note that some reimbursements were received in a different year from which they were invoiced. For example, certain invoices paid early in a particular year may be for leaves taken in the previous calendar year.

Section 59(1) of the Act provides that you may make a complaint about this decision to the Manitoba Ombudsman. You have 60 days from the receipt of this letter to make a complaint on the prescribed form to the Manitoba Ombudsman (Mail: 750-500 Portage Avenue, Winnipeg MB R3C 3X1; Telephone 204-982-9130 or 1-800-665-0531).

The information you requested was in an electronic format but not the format you requested, so we created a record for release to you under section 10(2), and, in accordance with section 14(1)(c) of the Act, a copy is enclosed.

10(2) - If a record exists but is not in the form requested by the applicant, the head of the public body may create a record in the form requested if the head is of the opinion that it would be simpler or less costly for the public body to do so.

Access to the reimbursements (date, union, and amount) is granted in full. Detailed information about the employees on whose behalf the amounts have been reimbursed was not provided, as this information is protected under s.14(1)(c) of the Act.

14(1) - The head of a public body shall refuse to disclose personal information to an applicant if the disclosure would be harmful to a third party's privacy.

Disclosure deemed to be an unreasonable invasion of privacy  
14(2) - A disclosure of personal information about a third party is deemed to be an unreasonable invasion of the third party's privacy if:  
(a) the personal information relates to the third party's employment, occupational or educational history;

Subsection 17(1) is a general mandatory exception which protects the personal information of third parties (third parties are considered to be neither you, the applicant or city employee). This general clause is used in conjunction with clause 17(2)(e), which is applied to information concerning employment history of individual employees.

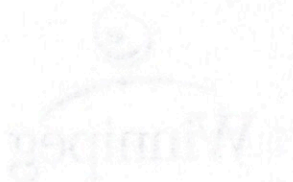

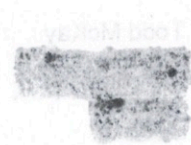
